

See Our Progress: Council Grove

Residents of Morris County have a more convenient way to access behavioral health services with the opening of our **new Council Grove office at 501 E. Main Street**. The facility officially began serving clients on June 16, and **unites services** previously provided at two separate locations—405 N. Union Street and 728 E. Main Street—into a single, modern space conveniently located near local schools. To celebrate this milestone, CrossWinds invites all supporters, community members, and local partners to attend an **open house on Friday, August 22, from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m.** Guests will have the opportunity to tour the new facility, meet staff, and learn more

about the expanded services now available to the Morris County community. The new space includes **private telehealth therapy rooms**, a significant **increase in square footage** for in-person counseling and group therapy, and a new **dedicated office for patient navigators**. Individuals seeking help can now complete **same-day intakes** and begin receiving services without delay, removing a significant barrier to care. The success of this project would not have been possible without generous support from partners and donors who believe in strong mental health care for rural Kansas. We thank the **Council Grove Area Foundation** for directly contributing to the renovation

and expansion of the facility’s group therapy areas, allowing for larger and more effective sessions that meet the growing needs of the community.

As we remain committed to delivering comprehensive behavioral health care across our seven-county catchment area, the new Council Grove office is a testament to that ongoing promise and of **more progress to come!**

CrossWinds Awarded \$158,760 in State Tax Credits to Support Reviving Rural Initiative

CrossWinds is excited to announce a recent award of **\$158,760 in Kansas Community Service Program tax credits** from the Kansas Department of Commerce! These tax credits will support our **Reviving Rural** initiative, a focused investment in improving behavioral health access in Coffey and Osage counties.

Reviving Rural will address barriers to care in underserved communities by **expanding the physical footprint and service capacity** of local clinics. In **Osage City**, CrossWinds is increasing the size of its current office by approximately 1,000 square feet. This expansion will provide space for **additional staffing, allow for same-day intakes, and introduce needed whole-body services.**

In Coffey County, CrossWinds has purchased a facility in **New Strawn** which will undergo **renovations to support the launch of local substance abuse services.** The renovated space will also allow for **expanded youth and adult group therapy programming**—services not currently available at this scale in the area.

If you're reading this, you can **help make these projects a reality by purchasing state tax credits.** Under the Community Service Program, donors contributing to the Reviving Rural campaign receive **70% of their donation amount back** in the form of a Kansas state income tax credit. These credits may be applied to either personal or business income taxes and are available on a **first-come, first-served basis.** All proceeds from tax credit donations will **directly support construction, renovation, and service expansion efforts in Coffey and Osage counties.**

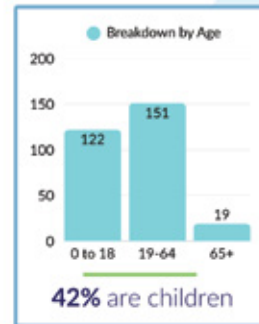

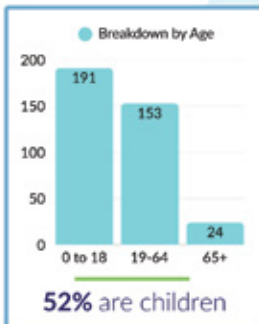
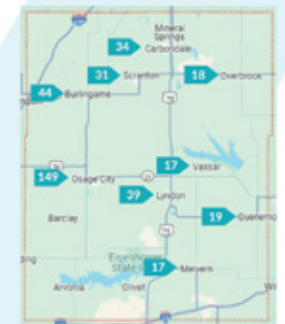
